GROWTH ENERGY SUPPORTS:

- ✓ Holding the EPA accountable for the excessive granting of unwarranted small refinery exemptions that further enrich oil companies at the expense of American farmers.
- ✓ Reallocating biofuel gallons lost to EPA's small refinery exemption (SRE) mismanagement and to ensure the program follows the law and Congressional intent.
- ✓ Increasing blending volumes through the RFS reset, which will set biofuel volumes from 2020-22, and provide a template for how EPA will handle the program after 2022.

GROWTH ENERGY OPPOSES:

- ⊘ Any anti-ethanol or anti-RFS legislation or regulation that decreases the use of biofuels (like excessive granting of SREs).

FINALIZE YEAR-ROUND E15 THROUGH EPA'S RVP RULEMAKING

GROWTH ENERGY SUPPORTS:

- ✓ EPA meeting its deadline of June 1, 2019.
- ✓ EPA removing any RIN reform language that hurts E15 retailers.

GROWTH ENERGY OPPOSES:

- ⊘ Any change to the rule that limits or disadvantages fuel retailers who are seeking to offer E15 to consumers.

OPEN INTERNATIONAL MARKETS

GROWTH ENERGY SUPPORTS EFFORTS TO:

- ✓ Opening up key trade markets that facilitate increased demand for American ethanol.
- ✓ Removing trade barriers that restrict U.S. ethanol exports from accessing and growing within international markets.
- ✓ Removing China's 70% tariff on U.S. ethanol.

GROWTH ENERGY OPPOSES:

- ⊘ Protective tariffs and duties that restrict our access to global markets.

SUPPORT ADVANCED AND CELLULOSIC BIOFUELS

GROWTH ENERGY SUPPORTS:

- ✓ Extending the second-generation biofuel producer tax credit.
- ✓ Having EPA approve registrations for facilities that plan to produce cellulosic biofuel under existing pathways approved by EPA.

- ⊘ Any legislation that limits investments and growth for advanced and cellulosic biofuels.
